IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All information as at June 2010, subject to alterations and printing errors.

Please, take the time to read this information carefully.

BEFORE THE ANKER HALFMARATHON

ELIGIBILITY

All runners age group 1993 and older, runners younger than 18 years need the consent of a legal representative. Participation on bicycles, inline skates, roller skates, skateboards and similar is not permitted and will result in disqualification.

REGISTRATION

1. By internet: the online registration form is attached at "**Race Infos / Events & Registration 2011**". Payment only by credit card (Visa or MasterCard). Please note down your password; you will need it to print your payment confirmation, report to the insurance company etc. etc.
2. By mail / fax: the printable registration form is attached at "**Race Infos / Events & Registration 2011**". Payment only by credit card (Visa or MasterCard).
The registration form must be completely filled in and personally signed by the participant. Registration forms which are sent in without signature and / or payment cannot be processed. Registration forms of minors must be signed by a legal representative.
3. Registration by phone is not possible.

Deadline for registrations sent in by post or telefax – date of postmark! Registrations after March 4, 2011 (as of midnight until April 1, 2011) can be done online only.

From March 4th to April 1st, registration is only possible on www.vienna-marathon.com

After March 4, 2011 (as of midnight until April 1, 2011, midnight), registration is possible via internet only.

Registration forms which are sent to the organiser by fax or post after March 4, 2011 cannot be accepted and / or processed.

For alterations and / or supplements to data sent in to the organizer by the participant a handling fee of € 11,- will be charged.

Late registration at the registration desk on April 15 and 16, 2011 (provided that entries are still available – please check the status on www.vienna-marathon.com): Euro 50,-

PAYMENT OF PARTICIPATION FEE

By credit card (Visa or MasterCard)

Registration forms with incomplete credit card data cannot be processed.

Due to organizational reasons, payment of the registration fee to a bank account is not possible.

For alterations and / or supplements to data sent in to the organizer by the participant a handling fee of € 11,- will be charged.

For registration by mail or fax an additional handling fee of € 5,- will be charged. In case of double registration a handling fee of € 10,- will be deducted from the amount to be refunded. Bank expenses caused by incorrect, incomplete or illegible data given on the entry form will be charged to the participant responsible.

A registered participant who fails to take part in the marathon, for whatever reasons, may not claim a refund of the participation fee.

INSURANCE

In case of online registration (Sportpayment) you have the possibility to conclude a special insurance for cancellation / withdrawal in case of illness. Details are announced at sportpayment.com

Please note that this is a special service rendered by Sportpayment. The insurance premium will be forwarded directly to the insurance company.

ENTRY LIMIT

IMPORTANT! Entries will be limited upon decision of the organizer.

Entries will be dealt with in the order of their in-coming. Early submission of the entry form will guarantee your participation in the ANKER Halfmarathon.

CONFIRMATION OF PARTICIPATION

1. Registration by internet: you will receive a confirmation on the screen and by e-mail with the allocated race number immediately after mailing the entry form. Please print this confirmation. As soon as your payment has been processed (which might take a short while), please print out your payment confirmation, using your password, at www.sportpayment.com / User Login. This confirmation has to be handed in when collecting the race documents.
2. Registration by mail or fax: the participants will receive written confirmations, stating the balance and the allocated race number.
Mailing of confirmations: approx. by mid March 2011.
The confirmation of participation has to be handed in upon collection of the race documents.
Possible deficits have to be balanced at the cashier's desk.

Please make sure that your e-mail address and postal address are given correctly, otherwise it will be impossible to mail the confirmation.

ALTERATIONS

Possible alterations and/or supplements to data given in the entry form can be made at the registration desk. For alterations and/or supplements to data given on the entry form by the participant a handling fee of € 11,- will be charged. Alterations will be considered in the final results. It is forbidden to pass on or sell the race number to another person (disqualification!)

REGISTRATION DESK

The registration desk will be at the fair VIENNA SPORTS WORLD, Vienna Int'l Fair (Wiener Messe), Hall D, 1020 Vienna (entrance from Trabrennstrasse, Subway station KRIEAU)

Opening hours: April 15 and 16, 2011 from 10.00am to 6.00pm.

IMPORTANT! NO collection of starting documents on April 17, 2011, the day of the race.

LATE ENTRIES AT THE REGISTRATION DESK PROVIDED THAT RACE NUMBERS ARE STILL AVAILABLE:

Late entry fee: Euro 50,-

Important notice: If the event is completely booked please note that race documents, which are not collected, will NOT be resold, passed on to another participant or changed in any way.

TIME - KEEPING / COMPUTER CHIP

Time keeping will be effected by means of a computer chip. In case you do not possess an own computer chip you will have to rent a WHITE DAY-chip at an accordingly marked counter **AFTER COLLECTING YOUR RACE DOCUMENTS**. Deposit and rental fee: € 10,-. The deposit fee of € 7,- will be refunded to you when handing back the chip in the finish area on Heldenplatz until 3.30 p.m.. Please note that the white chip can only be used for the events of the Vienna City Marathon!

You may also purchase a YELLOW chip for the amount of Euro 33,- which you may then use for other events.

Time-keeping is not possible without a computer chip (please tie it with the shoelaces). The chip is not transferable!

INTERNATIONAL FRIENDSHIP PARTY "KAISERSCHMARRN PARTY"

The traditional "Kaiserschmarrn Party" will be held on Saturday afternoon, April 16, 2011 at Vienna City Hall.

Free admission to the party.

Please make use of the opportunity to purchase tickets "ALL YOU CAN EAT" together with your online registration or directly at the entrance to City Hall. Costs for per ticket: Euro 8,- Free tickets for children registered for the Coca-Cola Kids Challenge, the Coca-Cola Run 4.2 as well as for children up to 12 years of age.

Pre-ordered / pre-paid tickets may be collected at a special desk in the registration area on April 15 and 16, 2011. Please see note on your race documents.

VCM T-SHIRT

You may purchase a special VCM T-Shirt during the process of online registration. A note regarding quantity and size of the ordered T-Shirt(s) will be made on your race documents. Please collect your T-Shirt at the T-Shirt desk. Please note that T-Shirts which are not collected will not be forwarded. They will be kept at the organization office for approx. 3 weeks and will then be given to a charity organization. By the time you may, of course, pick up your T-Shirt(s) at the organization office.

Special T-Shirt "Women only"

We offer the possibility to order a special T-Shirt for "women only".

AT THE START

GETTING TO THE START

The start of the Anker Halfmarathon is together with the Marathon on **Wagramerstrasse**. We kindly ask you to use public transport only. The starting area can be reached by subway "U1", disembark at station "**Alte Donau**". Please hand in your clothes in this area.

RACE NUMBER

Only participants wearing the official race number of the "ANKER Halfmarathon 2011" are permitted to start. **THE RACE NUMBERS ARE NOT TRANSFERABLE (disqualification)!** The race number has to be fixed at the front, must be clearly visible and must not be altered in any way, in particular the print. **FOR YOUR SECURITY** please write your name, the name of a person to contact as well as the address and phone number of this person on the reverse side of your race number. We also recommend that you note down possible allergies.

REGISTRATION OF CLOTHES

Registration of clothes from 7.00 am to 8.00 am close to the subway station "Alte Donau". Please put your clothes into the plastic bag you will receive at the registration desk as it is marked with your race number. Please do not put any articles of value or breakables into this bag. The organizer cannot be held liable for damage or loss. After the start your clothes will be transported to the finish area "Heldenplatz". Please collect your clothes until 4.30 p.m. at the latest. All clothes bags which are not collected after the race will be kept at the organizer's office for approx. 3 weeks after the race and disposed afterwards.

PLEASE NOTE

There will be no organized transportation from the finish area back to the start area. For security reasons only runners wearing the official race number are permitted to enter the start area.

TOILETS

A sufficient number of toilets will be available in the start and finish areas as well as along the course.

STARTING SEQUENCE

According to the best time given on the registration form you will be assigned to the respective starting block. It will be marked with a coloured dot on your race number. The colour of this dot corresponds with colour of the entrance gate to the block you have been assigned to. If you do not enter a best time at your registration you will have to start from the last block. Changes may be done at the registration desk. Block starts will be organized again from both sides of Wagramerstrasse.

ON THE COURSE

The following facilities will be provided every 5 kilometres: official intermediate time, first aid, refreshments at the food supply stations. From kilometre 15 onwards and also in the finish area fruit will additionally be available at the refreshment stations.

Please start drinking early enough, especially in warm weather!

You are kindly asked to deposit your cups and also fruit leftovers in the rubbish bins beside the course in consideration of the following runners.

COURSE

DISQUALIFICATION

Disqualification might be applied: if the participant registers under a false name; if the race number is not worn; if the race number is altered; in case of unsporting behaviour; if the participant is accompanied by a vehicle (bike, motorbike, car, inline skates and similar equipment with rollers), if the participant does not start from the assigned block, if the participant is not registered at the time-keeping

checkpoints; if the participant uses inline skates or other equipment with rollers); if the participant takes animals on the course, if the participant does not pass the course correctly.

TIME-KEEPING CHECKPOINTS

Unfortunately there are always runners trying to cut short the course. In order to avoid discussions later on, checkpoints in addition to the 5 km time-keeping points will be set up. If runners do not cross the time-keeping mats at these checkpoints they will be disqualified.

FIRST AID / MASSAGE

First-aid attendants will be positioned along the course and in the finish area in case medical assistance is required.

Massage will be provided in the finish area and also along the course.

Should you require medical assistance we recommend you try to keep on running or walking to the nearest first aid or refreshment station. There you will receive professional help. You may also ask another participant to get help for you.

Should you see a participant along the course who seems to be in a critical condition – according to your judgement – we ask you to inform the nearest first aid or refreshment station.

IN THE FINISH AREA

The finish area on "Heldenplatz" will be kept open until 12:00 a.m. Once you have crossed the finish line, your correct time and position is assured. Please proceed after crossing the finish line, as there are other participants following behind you.

A detailed plan of the finish area will be available on www.vienna-marathon.com.

Behind the finish line you will receive your medal and a special blanket to keep you warm (in case of bad weather). Refreshments will also be available in the finish area.

CHIP RETURN

Please hand back your time-keeping chip at the clearly marked counter on Heldenplatz and collect your deposit fee of € 7,-. The chip return will be kept open until 3.30 p.m.

COLLECTION OF CLOTHES

Please collect your clothes from the vehicle marked with your race number. Clothes can be handed out only upon presentation of the race number. Please collect your clothes until 4.30 p.m. at the latest. All clothes bags which are not collected after the race will be kept at the organizer's office for approx. 3 weeks after the race and disposed afterwards.

FIRST AID / MASSAGE

In case you do not feel well, please turn to any of the first aid stations to receive medical assistance. A massage service will also be provided in the finish area.

SHOWERS

Showers will be available in the finish area, provided by the Austrian Army.

AWARDS CEREMONY

The awards ceremony for the three best times overall will take place immediately after the race. Please follow the instructions of our staff.
